Todd Pressman, appointed to SWFWMD board

Gov. Charlie Crist has made one reappointment and one appointment of Tampa Bay area professionals to the governing board at the Southwest Florida Water Management District.

The moves still require Florida Senate confirmation.

Todd Pressman, owner and president of Pressman & Associates Inc. in Oldsmar, was reappointed for a term beginning April 1, 2010, and ending March 1, 2014. Pressman will continue as chairman of the 13-member board.

Jeffrey M. Adams of St. Petersburg, an attorney and partner with Abbey Adams, will succeed Sallie Parks. Adams was appointed for a term beginning April 1, 2010, and ending March 1, 2014.

The board establishes policies for the 16-county district. It represents a wide cross section of interests, including agricultural, recreational, business, industrial, urban, rural and the public.
